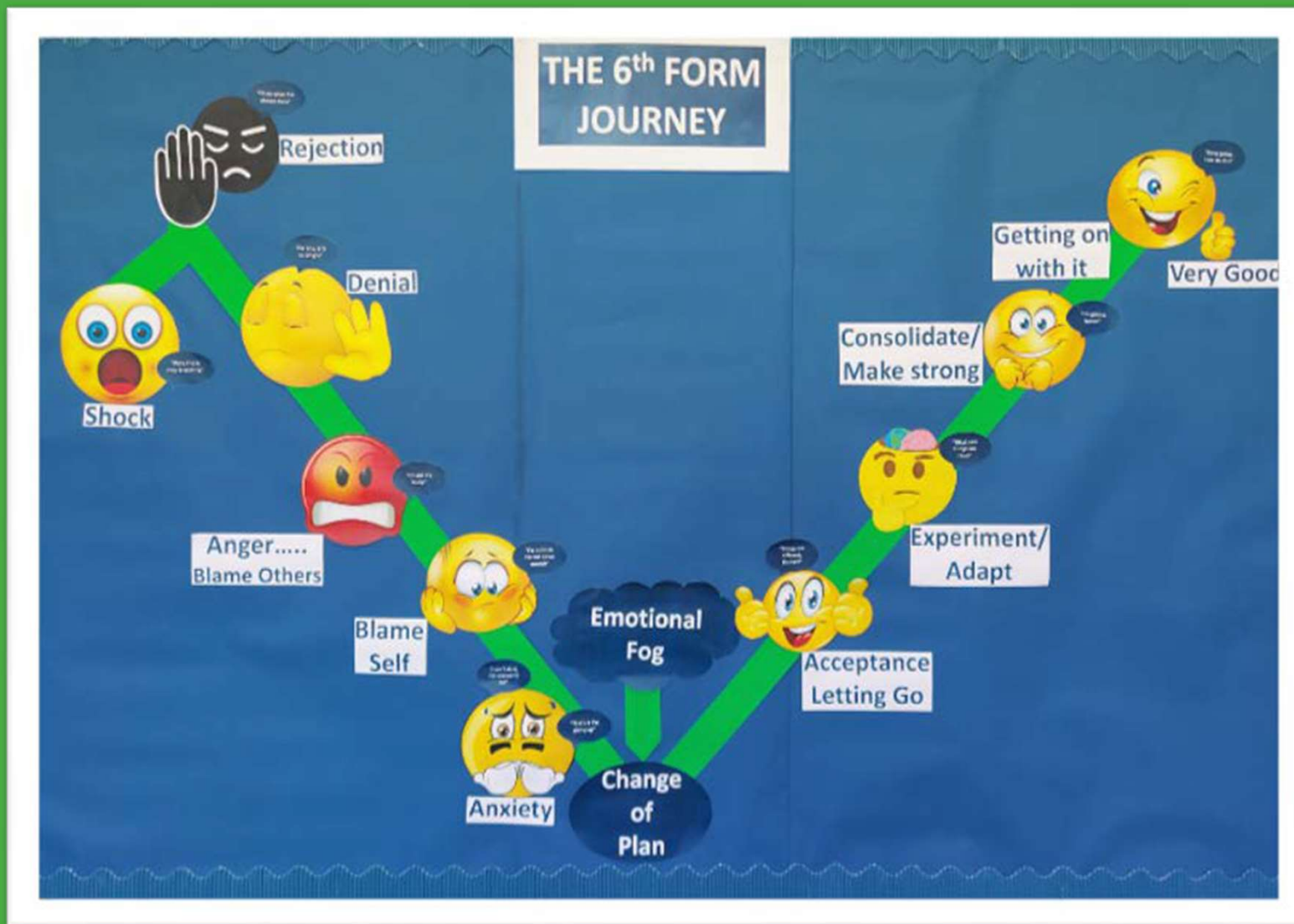

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Attendance

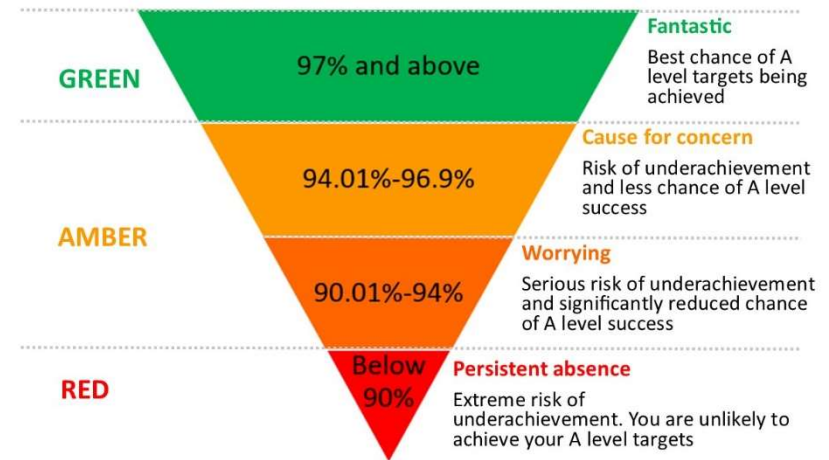
- Students are expected to attend and engage with all aspects of sixth form life. This includes all lessons, GLHs, registration, assemblies and enrichment

Withdrawal of Examination Entry Fees

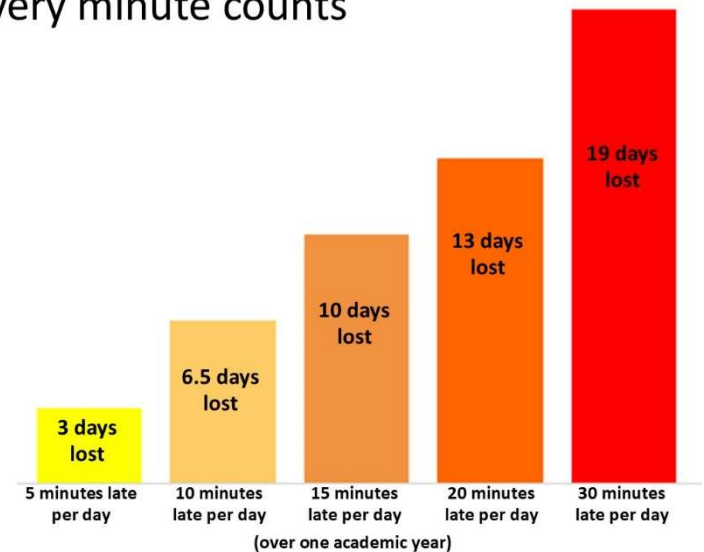

However, the school reserves the right to withdraw this payment for all or individual subjects the student is entered for on the grounds of attendance.
