Dear Parents and Carers

A huge congratulations to Year 11 students who have finished their formal timetable this week. Mrs Abingdon has sent out information on the revision schedule that will run after the break, and you will have seen in my letter last week that we are also offering silent study rooms for students who need a space to work in. These will both be on offer to all students in Year 11.

We wish our DofE Gold students in Year 12 the very best of luck as they embark on their practice expedition in Dartmoor this weekend. Those of you familiar with the DofE course will know about the increasing level of challenge as students take on terrains, conditions and levels of independence that test the skills that they have acquired. A huge thank you must go to Ms Hall and Mrs Jones for all of their support to prepare students, and on the expedition itself. We know that opportunities such as this cannot exist without their quite significant time and effort, often outside of normal school hours.

Immediately after the break on Monday 2nd June we have our second Federation student participation event, where Mr Williams and the Music team will take a group of students to Oathall Community College to perform. This comes after the success of the recent public speaking event and ahead of the upcoming Multi-sports event at Downlands on Friday 13th June and the Dance Show at Chequer Mead Theatre on Tuesday 17th June. We look forward to sharing more details of these excellent events with you and plan to continue to look for opportunities for student collaboration in our work with the Federation schools next academic year.

This is in the interests of staff and student safety and because of the demands on parking and car park access that comes with being a split site. Staff commuting to teach between sites have recently found their access has been impacted by increased traffic in and around our car parks. Next half term we should see the initial work towards our improvements at the Windmill Lane site starting. The first phase of these is due to be completed over the summer holidays, with the aim of having new student toilets in place for September 2025. The next phase that will take place over the academic year is the replacement of some of our modular buildings that are past their intended use life. This is a bigger project and a feasibility study is currently underway to determine how this will be fulfilled. We look forward to sharing more information on this with you in the coming months. Once we have the scope of this project we will be able to determine where we might also have the resources available to make further improvements to both sites in the interests of the whole school community, which remains a top priority for the school.
